Intervention-specific training requirements for CBA Providers and/or Health Department staff coordinating trainings with AED

Intervention title	Street Smart
# Training Days	4
Start/End times	8:30 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. on Days 1, 2, 3, 4
Training Coordination	AED requires a minimum of 6-8 weeks notice in advance of a training date to effectively coordinate training logistics. Under pre-approved circumstances where AED is <i>only</i> responsible for shipping materials, at least 4 weeks notice in advance of the training date is required.
Intervention Materials	<i>CBA Trainers will supply and ship intervention materials to each training.</i>
A/V needs for each training day	1 easel with newsprint LCD projector screen – <i>The trainers will bring a laptop and LCD projector to the training.</i> TV/VCR Video Camera – <i>The trainers may be able to provide if the HD cannot.</i>
Room set-up preferences for each training day	Main training room Chairs in a semi-circle configuration without tables, with the easel as a part of the circle Head table for trainer materials
Access to training room	Approximately 1 hour prior to training start time, each training day
Average Number of Participants	12 (minimum of 8); maximum 3 staff per agency CDC strongly recommends that two staff attend the training: 1) Two facilitators who will be delivering the intervention session and 2) if possible, the implementing CBO's Project Coordinator or Program Manager that oversees the intervention.
Training Materials and Supplies	<i>CBA Trainers will supply and ship training materials and supplies to each training, including CDC required documents</i>
PLEASE NOTE: All DEBI Project trainings must be accessible to individuals with disabilities, including training space, toilet facilities, and interior/exterior routes to the training location that accommodate persons in wheelchairs.
