**Intervention-specific training needs for CBA Providers and/or Health**  
**Department staff coordinating trainings with AED**

Intervention title	<b>Safety Counts and Safety Counts Spanish</b>
Start/End times	8:30 am – 5:00 pm
# Training Days	3 days (in some cases, may be 2 days)
Training Coordination	AED requires a <b>minimum of 6-8 weeks notice in advance</b> of a training date to effectively coordinate training logistics. Under pre-approved circumstances where AED is <i>only</i> responsible for shipping materials, at least 4 weeks notice in advance of the training date is required.
Kit Details	AED reproduces training materials, including Program Manuals (1 per participant) with Recruitment & Retention Materials and Safety Counts PowerPoint, Safety Counts CD-ROM/DVD (1 per participant), Participant folders (1 per participant), and CDC-IDU documents ( <i>currently out of stock</i> ), CDC Hepatitis brochures
Where/When to send Kits	Kits (3-ring binders) and Trainers' Supplies are shipped to training location, to arrive at least 2 days prior
Space and A/V needs	1 main training room (all days) 1 TV/DVD player ( <b>Day 1 only</b> ) 2 easels with newsprint/room (all days) laptop/LCD or projector and screen (all days) ability to display newsprint (5 stages of change, core elements) on the walls)
Room set-up preferences	Round tables for 6-8 Head table for trainers Table for placement of IDU fact sheets
Access to training room	Approximately 1 hour prior to training start time
Maximum Number of Participants	25 <i>CDC strongly recommends that two staff per agency attend the training: 1) the implementing CBO's Executive Director or Program Manager that oversees the intervention; and 2) the Counselor that delivers Safety Counts group and individual sessions.</i>
Supplies (AED provides)	Program Manuals (with Recruitment & Retention Materials and Safety Counts PowerPoint) Safety Counts CD-ROM/DVD Participant Folders (containing participant list, DEBI and SCts fact sheets, Participant Satisfaction Questionnaires, Hepatitis brochures, Form 0.113,) Certificates Name tags (full page – 2 column) Table Tents Role Play Scenarios (1 set per participant) Newsprint with Stages of Stage and Core Elements (1 set)
Copies (AED provides)	Sign-in sheets FedEx envelopes/pre-addressed slips to send PSQs back to AED
